Throughout the day, a number of hard-hitting topics will be covered, as we feel this is important in ensuring every child understands wider issues, and that as professionals we educate them in understanding these topics, to ultimately protect them in what can now be a difficult world to grow up in.

During the day students will be introduced to their own account for Classcharts. Students will learn how to analyse their own behavior for learning, track how many house points they have and become familiar with the homework function. Students will initially set up their accounts via their mobile phones and therefore we will be allowing students to bring their mobile phones in to use for one period of this day. The school will allow students to access Wi-Fi; to speed up this process up, please could students download the **Classcharts Student** app. They can do this from either Apple Store or Google Play before hand – any student without access to a mobile phone will be afforded a computer for that period.

Students will be required to wear full school uniform for this day.

This day proves to be an exciting, fun filled and thought-provoking day for all. This will enable students to have a better understanding of the wider world, making them less vulnerable and more able to easily identify situations that put themselves or others in danger.
