Think Ahead Day Thursday 16 January 2020

On Thursday 16 January, we will be holding our third annual 'Think Ahead' Day. This is a day when we suspend the usual timetable and different year groups pursue curriculum enrichment activities appropriate for the stage they have reached in their secondary schooling.

- Year 7 will have a Maths Puzzle Day with activities designed to stretch logical and numerical thinking.
- Year 8 will attend options taster lessons to help them with decisions about options subjects.
- Year 9 will pursue lessons in thinking skills and examination skills as they settle into their GCSE courses.
- Year 10 will have a talk on apprenticeships, and then lessons preparing them for the world of work and work experience, which they will undertake later this year.
