#### **School and Work will continue**


- Students will be expected to be online for lessons and completing work at home.

- Thursday 8:45am weekly year group assembly via zoom link posted in Y10 Support Classroom



When will students be returning to school?


At present the government has said the National Lockdown will be until at least the end of this half term (February 15<sup>th</sup>). We do not have any further information than you do on whether this will be extended. Please keep an eye of the news for updates.

#### When will students have live lessons for their subjects?

- We will be using the timetable that I highlighted earlier. Tutor time is synchronous (live) everyday at 8:45am with an assembly every Thursday morning.
- The lessons will be on a rota basis as shown in this image. S means a synchronous (live) lesson through Google Meet and A means an asynchronous (nonlive) lesson where work is posted online for students to complete and submit.

Will the RS PPE go ahead?

Yes it will go ahead HOWEVER, we have postponed this for the moment and the date is to be confirmed once we know when students will definitely be returning.

What is happening with the RS GCSE?

We are awaiting clarification with regards to the RS examination and if this will be Centre Assessed Grades (CAG) at present the government has just confirmed that Year 11 GCSEs will be CAG.

What is happening with the iMedia exam?

Students are still being entered for the coursework and exam unit that was at the end of this year – HOWEVER, we are awaiting guidance still – nothing further has been released since the government announcement.

Will PPEs in all of the other subjects still go ahead?

The have been postponed for the meantime. They will have a rescheduled date – once this is confirmed I will let you know
