- Please could you discuss with your child and ensure they bring a face covering to school.



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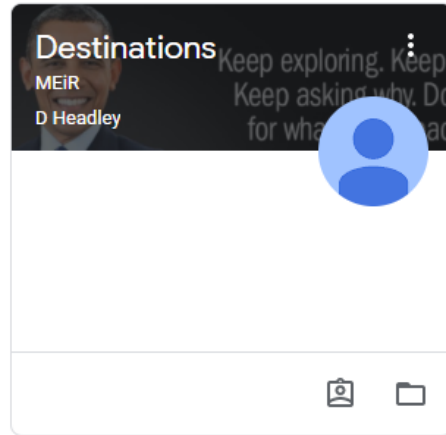
# Student reports

- Staff in school will be discussing strengths and the areas for improvement that they show.

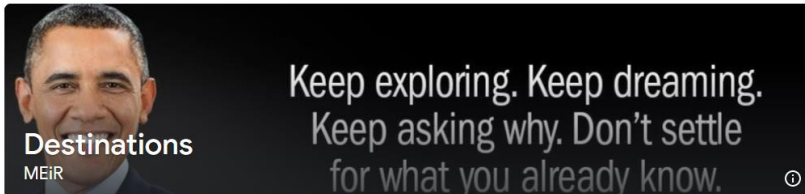
