Covid testing of students on their return in January 2022

Where consent has been provided, students will be tested for Covid-19 once on their return to school in January 2022. All students will be tested on Wednesday 5 January. The arrival times per tutor group are as follows, testing should be completed within 30 minutes of the arrival time:

Students should enter the school via the PE gates, where consent will be checked and they will be taken through to the testing centre as appropriate. Please do not send your child in to be tested if consent has not been provided, we will be unable to test your child in school if consent was not provided by 9:00am on 13 December 2021. Please can we ask that your child arrives promptly at the stated time as we will have a lot of tests to get through that day.

Work will be made available to students via Google Classroom for Wednesday 5 January. All students will be expected back for face to face lessons on **Thursday 6 January**. Please could I remind all parents to ensure that students return to school with the correct uniform (including footwear) and with the correct equipment.

Home Testing

All students have been provided with 2 boxes of home test kits, **which are double nasal swab only**. Please encourage your child to test themselves regularly, at least twice a week. Results should continue to be reported to the school <u>here</u> and to the NHS <u>here</u>. Contact tracing over the holidays will remain the responsibility of NHS Test & Trace.

Vaccinations

We are awaiting confirmation of the date that the School Nursing team will be in school to deliver further Covid vaccinations. This will be the second dose for students who have already received their first dose or the first dose for those students who have not yet been vaccinated at all. A consent form will be issued once the date is confirmed. It is not advised to be vaccinated within 90 days of a positive covid-19 result.

If you wish to make your own arrangements for your child to be vaccinated, the National Booking Service will be opening for this cohort from 20 December 2021. If your child is eligible and you wish for them to have it outside of school please follow the link below.
