Year 11 Revision Corridors and Pre-Public Examinations

Students in year 11 will be having their Pre-public Examinations ('PPE's) from 1 March – 10 March 2022. During this time, students will sit exams in all subjects. All will be sat under exam conditions. As year 11 face significant pressure during these exam periods they will be allowed to leave school slightly early on the following days to continue with their studies at home. For the exams on Tuesday 1 March, Wednesday 2 March and Thursday 3 March, students will leave school immediately after the Science exam. On Friday 4 March those that are sitting the Geography exam will leave school after the exam finishes, (those not sitting Geography will be in normal lessons). Students should also carefully check their examination timetable as some exams end after the end of the school day.

These examinations are an important opportunity for students to demonstrate their knowledge and understanding of topics and prepare for their GCSEs. It is imperative that students take these exams as seriously as they would their real GCSEs. As detailed in Mrs Gibbs' letter on 21 October should the school be required to provide Centre Assessed Grades for students then these PPEs would provide part of the evidence base for grades given to students.

There is an examinations Google Classroom for all student to access with useful information and videos. The class code for this is: **tsurbon**. Information has also been shared with students this week via ClassCharts announcements and an announcement in the year 11 Support Google Classroom.

Students should be reminded that these examinations should be treated as if they are their real GCSE examinations and as such they will be expected to follow all rules and expectations put in place, failure to do so could result in the student being seen as committing an exam malpractice offense.

Students will be required to have full, correct, uniform to enter the exam hall and will need to bring equipment to their exams, we are unable to provide equipment to students. Equipment should be in a clear, plain, pencil case. The equipment needed is:

- Black pen (including spares);
- Pencil;
- Ruler:
- Eraser:
- Pencil sharpener;
- Scientific Calculator (recommended: Casio FX-83GTX Scientific Calculator/Casio fx85GTX Scientific Calculator);
- Protractor (for Mathematics);
- · Compass (for Mathematics).

These are important exams and are a key opportunity for students to assess their own progress and understanding of the subjects they are studying. As such, students should begin preparing for these exams early, students were informed of the dates of the PPEs in our first assembly of the year in order to aid this preparation and have been given access to the examination timetable via the google classroom. A copy is included with this letter. To further

support with this we will be holding revision corridor sessions after school to support students. These sessions are open to all students taking the subjects, however a small number of students may also be invited to attend. If your child is invited to attend a session you will receive a letter informing of this and your child will be expected to attend unless you inform the school of a prior commitment. Any student individually invited has been selected as their teacher feels that they would benefit from attending. I have included an overview document so that you are able to see the dates and times of all sessions. I would ask that you encourage your child to be attending these revision corridor sessions and completing additional revision at home. We have access to GCSEPod, a brilliant online learning platform, that all students can access to aid their revision, in addition to subject specific resources such as HegartyMaths and Kerboodle. A number of departments also utilise Google Classroom for revision support. I would also ask that where this is possible, support them with providing a quiet space for revision or assist them with creating a revision timetable.
