The individual report has been re-styled following feedback from students, parents and staff received during the “Reporting to Parents Review” conducted last year. At this stage we have made a few small changes to the report that will hopefully make it clearer and more accessible for parents:

- The former codes used for “Behaviours for Learning” have now been replaced by simple statements.
- Some of the tracking detail has been removed to support clarity of understanding.
- A hyperlink to the scale descriptors used by each subject to indicate the skills and knowledge that your child is using in their learning.

The work of improving our assessment and reporting to parents will continue with two specific areas of focus. These areas are:

- Tracking and reporting assessment, particularly in KS3.
- Reporting engagement by reviewing further the behaviours for learning approach.

I would like to thank those parents who responded to the survey in the summer and to those who took part in the subsequent virtual meeting to discuss the questions raised.
