## Year 8, Winchester Science Centre Trip, Wednesday 12 July 2023

We have secured a limited number of tickets for a Year 8 trip to Winchester Science Centre & Planetarium on Wednesday 12 July 2023. We will be leaving the school at 9am and returning at approximately 3pm. Students will be taking part in a 45 minute curriculum linked discovery workshop, a live planetarium show, and will be given time to visit the interactive exhibitions in the centre. The visit aims to spark students' curiosity and help them make connections with things that they have learnt in school. Students will need to bring a packed lunch and should wear school uniform as usual.

As this is a recreational trip, there will be a charge of £16.75 per student and without this full contribution, the trip will be unable to go ahead. **Please note that payment is non-refundable** This payment will cover transport and admission to the centre, including a dedicated workshop. The trip is open to all Year 8 students but tickets are limited and payment should be made via ParentPay without delay to avoid disappointment.

We may be able to provide financial assistance for students registered for pupil premium funding.
