Dear Parent/Guardian

I am writing to confirm our plans for Key Stage 4 Results Day on Thursday 22 August 2024, and provide guidance on post results services this year.

Results Day – Thursday 22 August

We would like to invite students to arrive between 10:00-11:00. Students should arrive through the front entrance and head to the Main Hall where they will need to go to the relevant tutor group table to collect and sign for their results – this envelope will contain a voucher for the ice cream van that will be outside.

Students will then be able to head into the atrium where they can socialise with their peers and members of staff before heading outside to claim their free ice cream. There will also be staff on hand if students wish to seek guidance about their results and/or next steps.

A summary candidate statement of results will also be sent to their **student school googlemail account** and will be published to both the Bromcom Student Portal and also My Child At School after midday on Results Day.

If they would like their results collected by someone else on their behalf, emailed to an address other than their school googlemail address or if they would like their results posted *to a UK address*, please complete [this survey here](#) by midday on 21 August 2024. Please note, emails and post will be sent after midday on 22 August.

The nominated person must have the student's permission to collect the results on their behalf. **The named nominee must also bring photo ID for themselves.** We will not release results to third parties under any other circumstances.

Donations of books and uniform

If your child would like to donate to the school any of their textbooks (including their set English literature texts - *A Christmas Carol*, *Macbeth* and *An Inspector Calls*) and revision guides that you no longer have any need for, we would like to use them for students who cannot buy their own copies of the texts, and to have as spares to lend to students who forget books. We will also pass on donated revision guides if your child no longer wants them.

If you would like to donate any aspects of the school uniform, especially blazers, ties and PE kit, which are still in **good, clean** condition, we would be very grateful to receive these items too.
