# You Said ... We Did

You want more regular communication from school about your child and the structure of your child's year group.

The Class Charts App will notify you of positive and negative behaviours reported by staff during every school day. A letter is sent home at the start of the year from each Head of Year to all parents, introducing themselves and outlining their plans for the year. We have also now added their names, along with the names of tutors, to the [school website](#) and will update it each academic year.

Unfortunately, we cannot make them any longer, as teachers have many students to fit in, however, the Student Progress Day in December provides an opportunity to discuss your child's development across all aspects of school in more depth.
