The Prompts:

- ☀️ Set in a Place You'd Like to Visit on Holiday - this could be a real place or a fantasy setting
- ☀️ Author with the Initials M, E or R - this could be first initials, last initials or a combination
- ☀️ Favourite Colour on the Cover - this could be the background colour or part of a design on the cover
- ☀️ A Book from a Library - this could be a physical book from the school library, an ebook from ePlatform or an audiobook from one of the Reading/Wokingham Libraries
- ☀️ Read a Book Outside - this can be done in a park, a garden, at the beach, wherever you desire so long as it's read completely outside
- ☀️ An Elemental Book - this could be a book with an element from the periodic table in the title or on the cover, or a book with one of the elements of nature (fire, water, air, earth, light, dark)
- ☀️ Features Your Favourite Subject - this could be a non-fiction read about your favourite subject or a fiction read that features your favourite subject
- ☀️ A 5 Star Prediction - this could be any book that you think will be amazing, even if it doesn't end up being all that great, it's the prediction that matters most!
- ☀️ A Genre You Don't Usually Read - this can be any book that is outside of your regular reading habits
